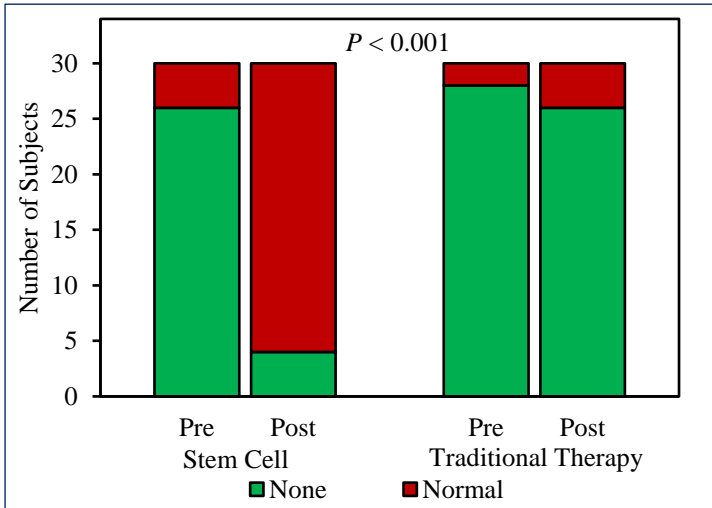


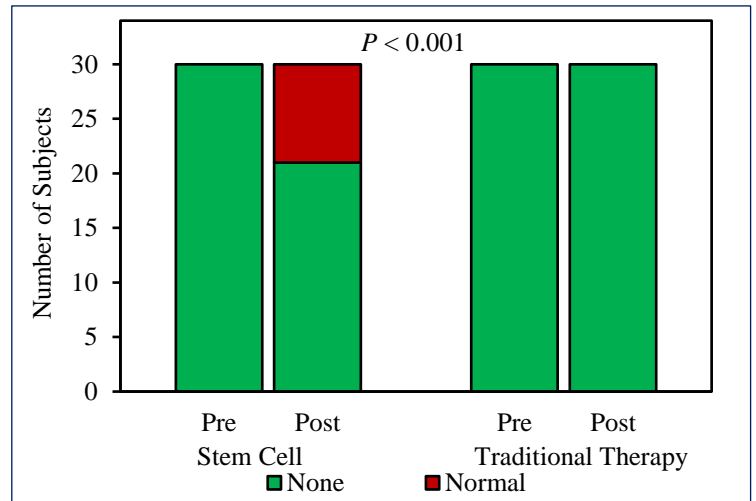
SPINAL CORD INJURY

Intravenous plus intrathecal administration of human umbilical cord blood cells was evaluated in 30 subjects with spinal cord injury. These subjects showed significant improvement in pain and temperature sensation, lower limb muscle strength, bladder and gastrointestinal function.

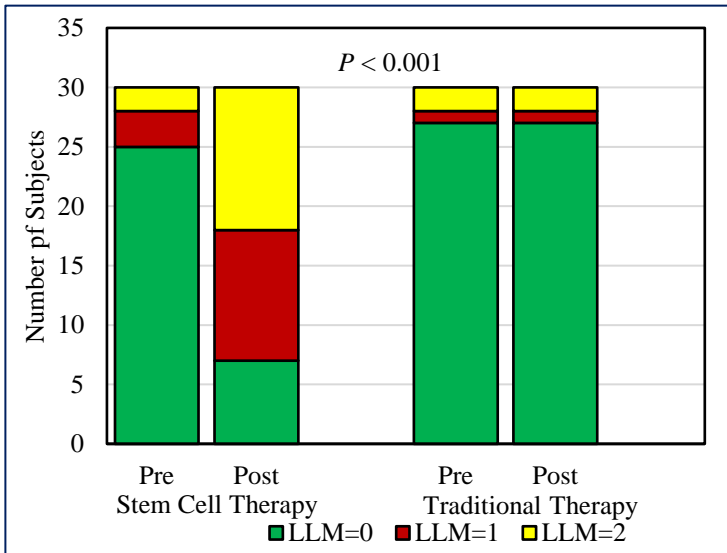
A. Changes in pain sensation
